

Quarterly Headlines

The MSCI Emerging Markets Small Cap Index declined significantly over the quarter. Europe, Middle East and Africa was the best performing region, led by Turkey, Kuwait and the United Arab Emirates. Poland and Saudi Arabia were notable laggards. Asia fell in line with the Index with China, Taiwan and India outperforming the broader Index but still declining in absolute terms. South Korea was the worst performing market as abrupt political instability unsettled investors. Latin America was the worst performing region with Brazil being the biggest detractor due to a deteriorating fiscal outlook. A strong US dollar was also a headwind for emerging market returns.

The Emerging Markets Small Cap Fund provided significant downside protection during the quarter, outperforming the Index by 2.9%. Positive contributions came from the portfolio's strong stock selection in Taiwan and India, as well as positioning in South Korea. Negative contributions came from stock selection in Indonesia and the lack of exposure to Turkey.

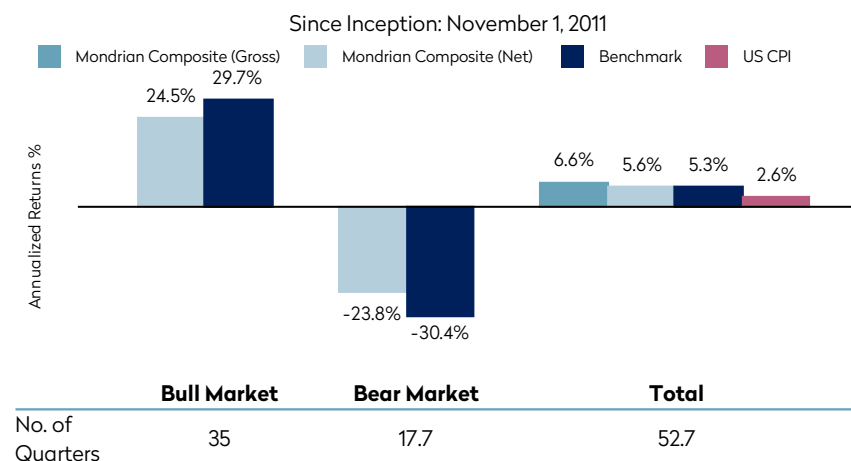
